Overview

Warriors Christian Academy strives to be distinctively Christian by developing the Christian worldview through an academically rigorous individualized educational program utilizing ACE curriculum.

Warriors Christian Academy exists to give its students a complete God-centered orientation of life, providing them with an education founded on a thoroughly Christian and biblical worldview, with the goal of developing the image of God in our students.

The ACE curriculum track at Warriors Academy is designed to meet the current demand for Christian education created by a growing awareness of the educational, moral and spiritual deficiencies of the public educational system. The program is scalable and reproducible so that we can respond to the need to disciple a generation with a genuine Christian education. The current market has a wide range of where students are at, requiring individualized instruction for each student according to their need. ACE learning centers accomplish this by diagnosing the current level of each student and placing them in a curriculum where they can succeed and learn. One of the byproducts of ACE curriculum is teaching students that they are able to learn any subject through hard work and discipline.

The high school program requires students to complete 26 credits. Courses completed at other schools may be substituted for graduation requirements at the discretion of school administration. PE and elective credits will be earned by students according to meeting 120 combined in-class hours in PE and martial arts. Electives can be chosen from a number of ACE electives that are available such as health, the Constitution, general business, accounting and a number of other options.

Homework and Homeschool Requirements

Each student will set goals to complete the required coursework for each year in our learning centers. If goals are not completed, they will be required to complete their goals at home. For students attending less than five days per week, they will be required to complete a commensurate amount of work at home when not attending classes on campus.
